'The Church Colleges' Certificate in Children's Ministry' could be just right for you!

The 'Church Colleges' Certificate in Children's Ministry' Course

This is a one year, part time course, validated by the University of Chester, leading to the nationally recognised Church Colleges' Certificate in Children's Ministry

Content

3 modules each lasting one term:

Understanding Childhood, The Bible and Children, Children and Worship

Placement at a church other than your own for wider experience and reflective learning

Assessment

Two tasks totalling 4,000 words (or equivalent) per module.

(It is possible to take the course without being assessed, in which case you will receive a Certificate of Attendance but not the Church Colleges' Certificate.)

Practicalities

- The course lasts 3 terms, starting September 2011
- 6 evenings, 2 Saturdays, 2 placement visits per term
- Venue: St George's Church Hall Altrincham WA14 4DE
- There are no academic entry requirements but you will need to be actively involved in children's ministry in a church context, and have your church minister's support.
- A new Enhanced CRB will be required as part of the application process.
