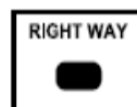

As well as supporting the work of your local church, a part of what you give supports over 700 ministers working in the diocese – this contribution is known as Parish Share. Through Parish Share, all parishes in the diocese contribute to the ongoing education of Readers, training for clergy and other support and development resources. Around 175 clergy also have housing, pensions and a stipend to be paid for at a cost of over £50,000 per person per year.

In order to calculate levels of mutual support we need to take account of worshippers' incomes. Average income levels at each parish, along with data on congregation size over the last three years, are used to calculate the proportion of the overall diocesan budget requirement that your parish will be asked to prayerfully contribute. By providing the information on this confidential and anonymous form you can help to set the right Parish Share for your church.
